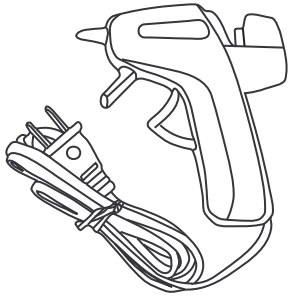
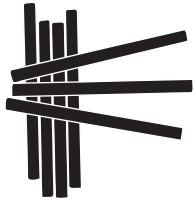


Wax Stamp or sealer



Fauxwax requires a mini glue gun (5/16" sticks)

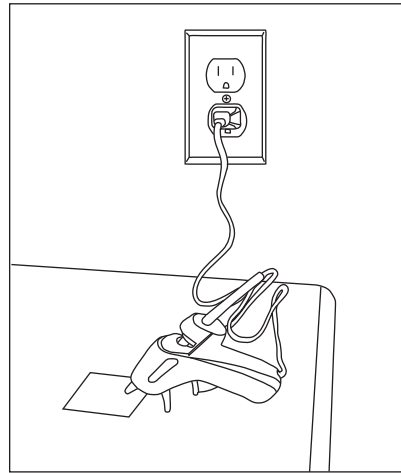


Enough Fauxwax sticks to complete your project.



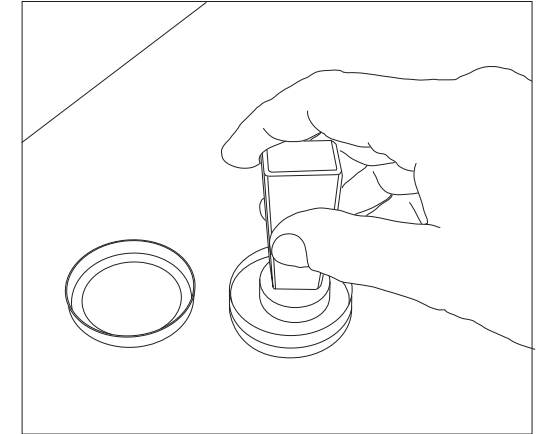
To prevent sticking of the fauxwax to the stamp, we recommend using either Non-stick (shown above) heavy duty silicone spray, or ice cubes.

Items needed for sealing



Plug your mini glue gun into a 110V wall outlet or extension cord. Make sure that you have something placed under the nozzle to prevent sticking of wax drips to your work surface.

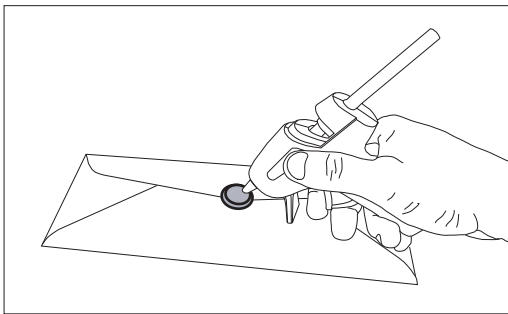
Step 1



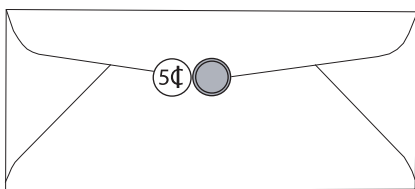
Push the bottom of the wax stamp into the non stick compound.

You can also use Ice cubes or silicone spray to prevent sticking of the Fauxwax to the stamp.

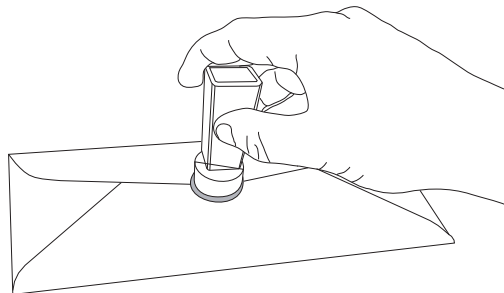
Step 2



for our standard size seal (1 1/8" round), place a nickel sized "blob" onto the surface that you plan to make a seal on. The size of the "blob" will depend on the diameter of the stamp.



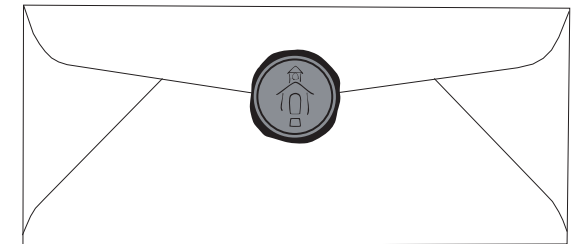
Step 3



Using firm pressure, press the stamp down into the wax until the wax pushes out around the stamp to the desired shape.

You may want to try a few practice seals before tackling your show project!!

Step 4



Your finished seal should come out looking just the way you like. (with some minor "authentic blemishes" possibly)

Note: to get just the right "look" you will need to experiment with wax quantity and sealing technique. These instructions are a basic guideline.
